

The Children's Peace Monument

The Children's Peace Monument was unveiled on May 5, 1958. The movement to raise the monument was inspired by the death of Sadako Sasaki. It is dedicated to all the children who died as a result of the atomic bombing. On top of the monument is a statue of a girl holding a paper crane. Today, paper cranes are sent to Hiroshima from all over the world. The paper crane has become a symbol of peace.
